As part of this year's Design at Large section, which is curated by celebrated French photographer François Halard, Laffanour Downtown is presenting a striking set of furniture by the Italian design legend Gaetano Pesce. In 1994, Pesce was commissioned to mastermind the architecture and the interior for Dujardin children store on the Belgian coast. Featuring his signature passion for whimsical aesthetics with everyday functionality, the result was a vibrant imaginary world. On display, visitors will find the original shelves and cloakrooms from the store, an example of how Pesce's designs are as relevant today as they were 20 years ago.
